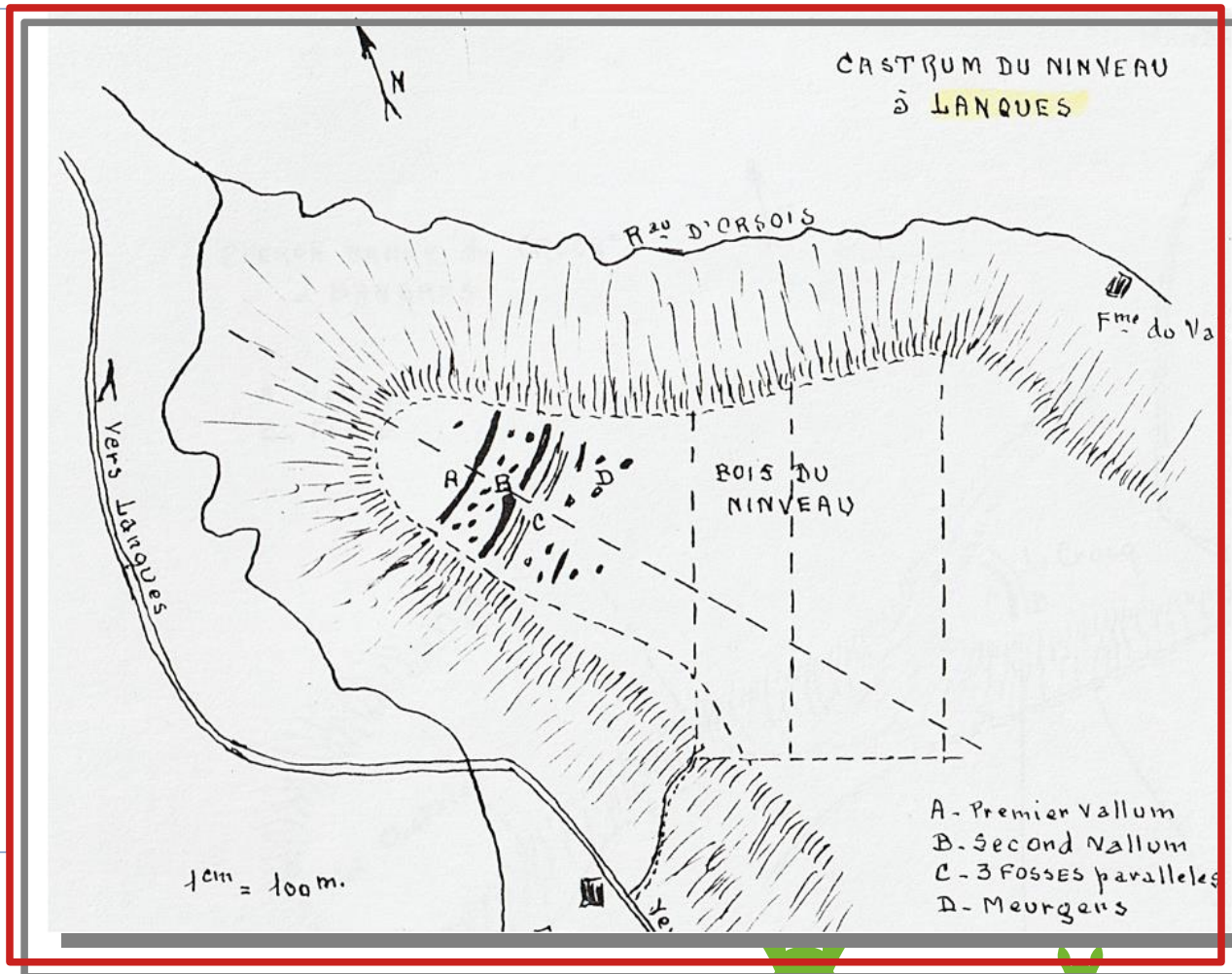
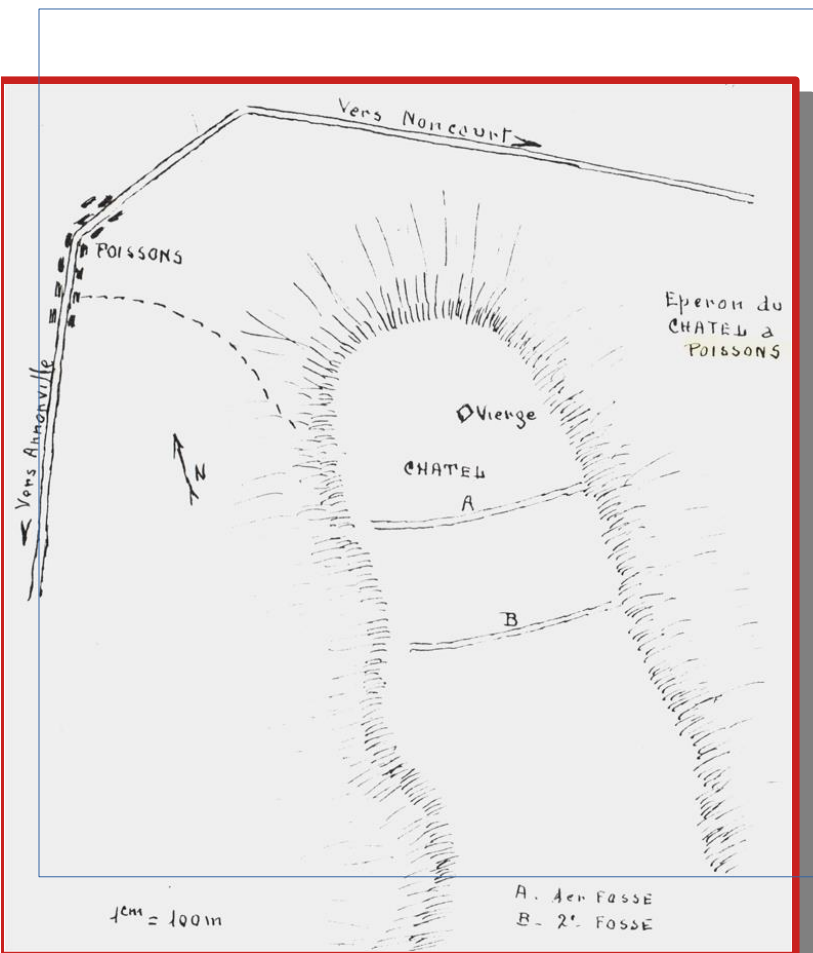
Plan schématique. 1. Plateau ; 2. Fossé ;

5. Butte artificielle ; 6. Sentier ; 7. Source.



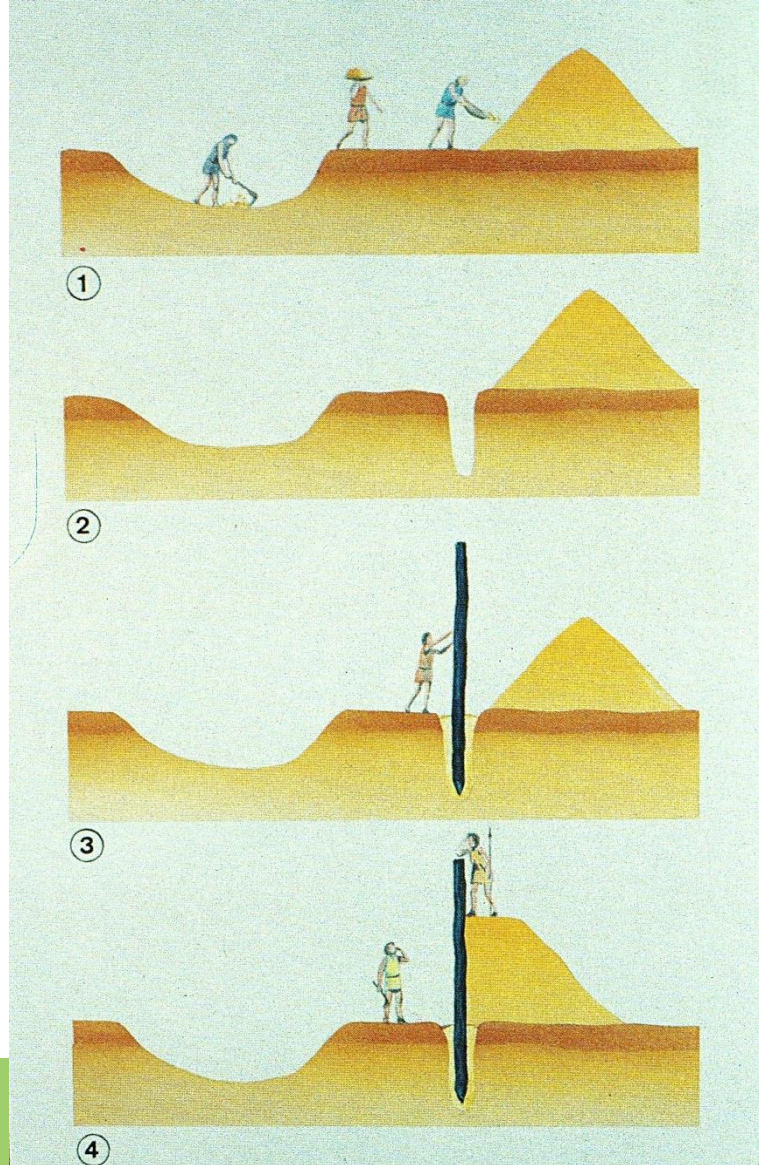

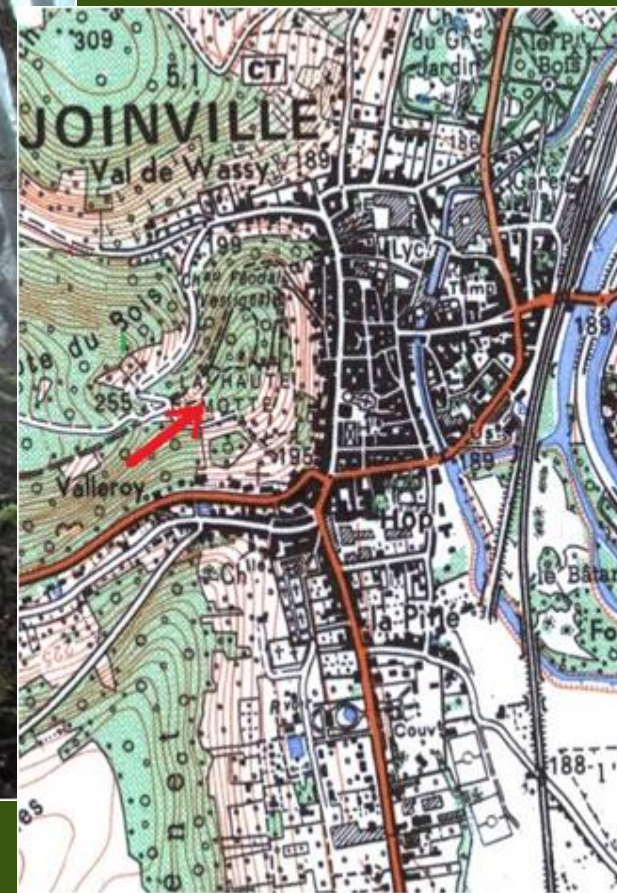

(336) PARGNY-sous-Mureau (canton de Neufchâteau)

Au Xe s., "Castrum scilicet de Reuvalt et de Pauniaco" ; en 1180, "Altare de Parneio",

D'après les formes anciennes, on peut hésiter entre plusieurs noms d'hommes latins ;

PATRINIUS, PARENTIUS ; en tout cas, nous avons bien le suffixe -(I)ACUM.

Mureau est un hameau ; en 971, "(D, de) Mirunvalt" ; sans doute influence de fr. "mur" ; mais la forme ancienne nous présente le germanique WALD 'bois', précédé d'un n.h. au cas-régime.,

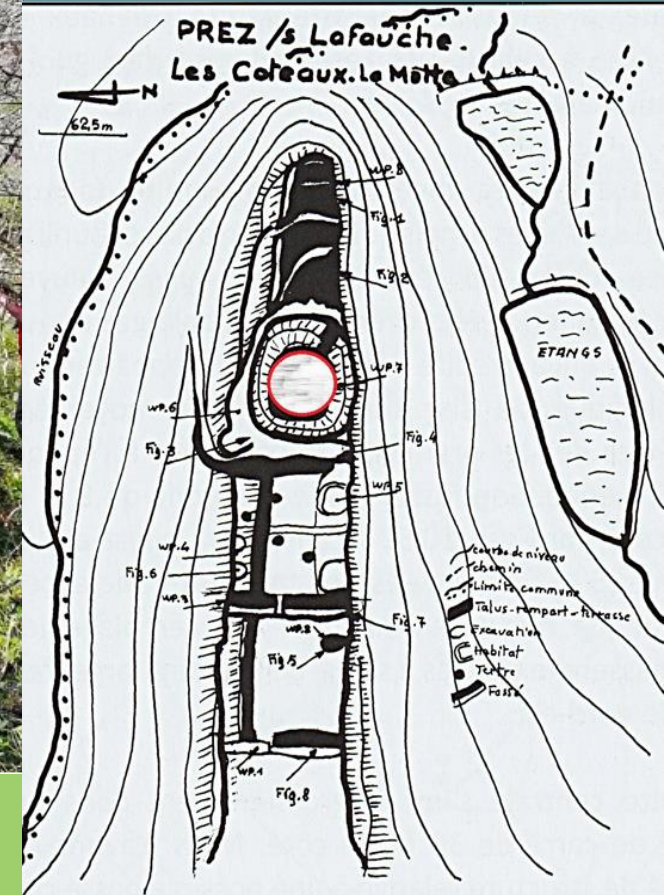

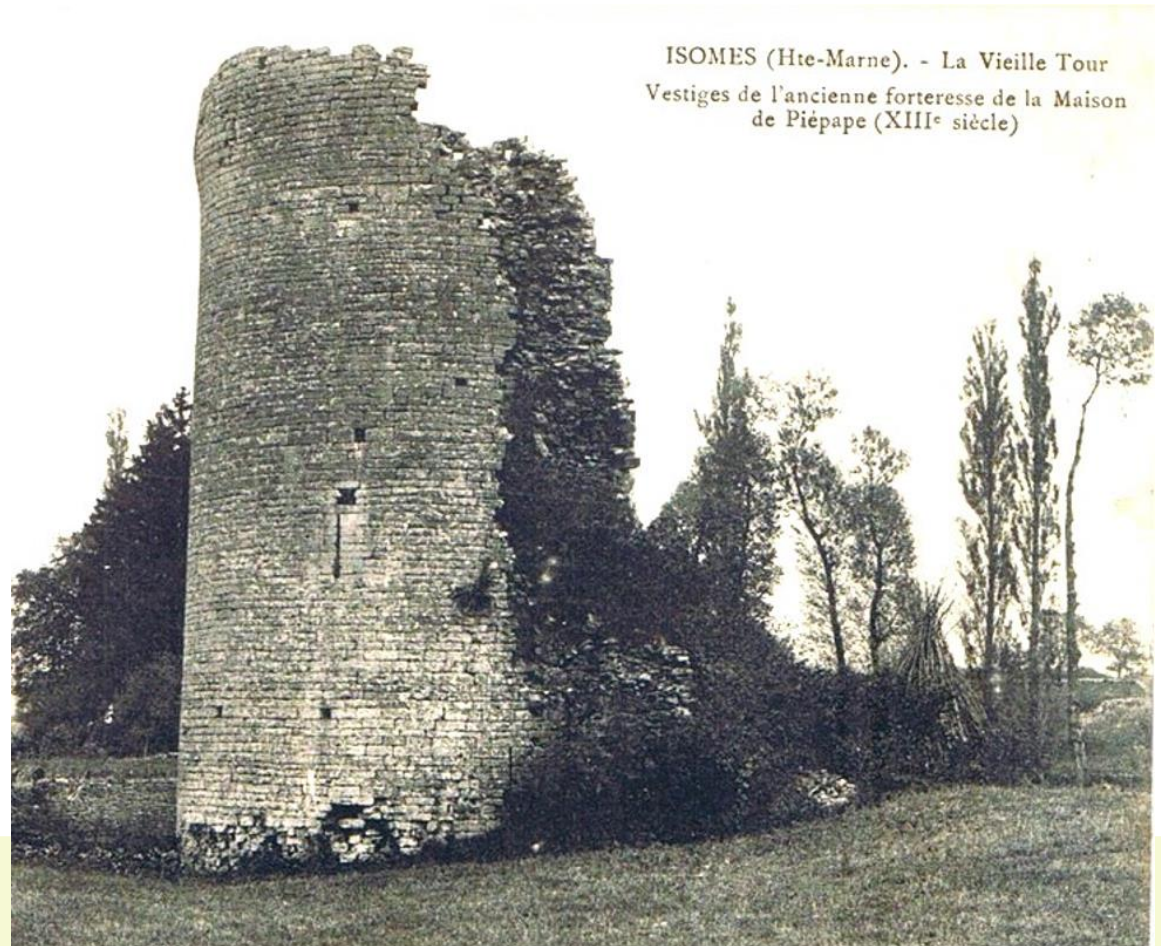
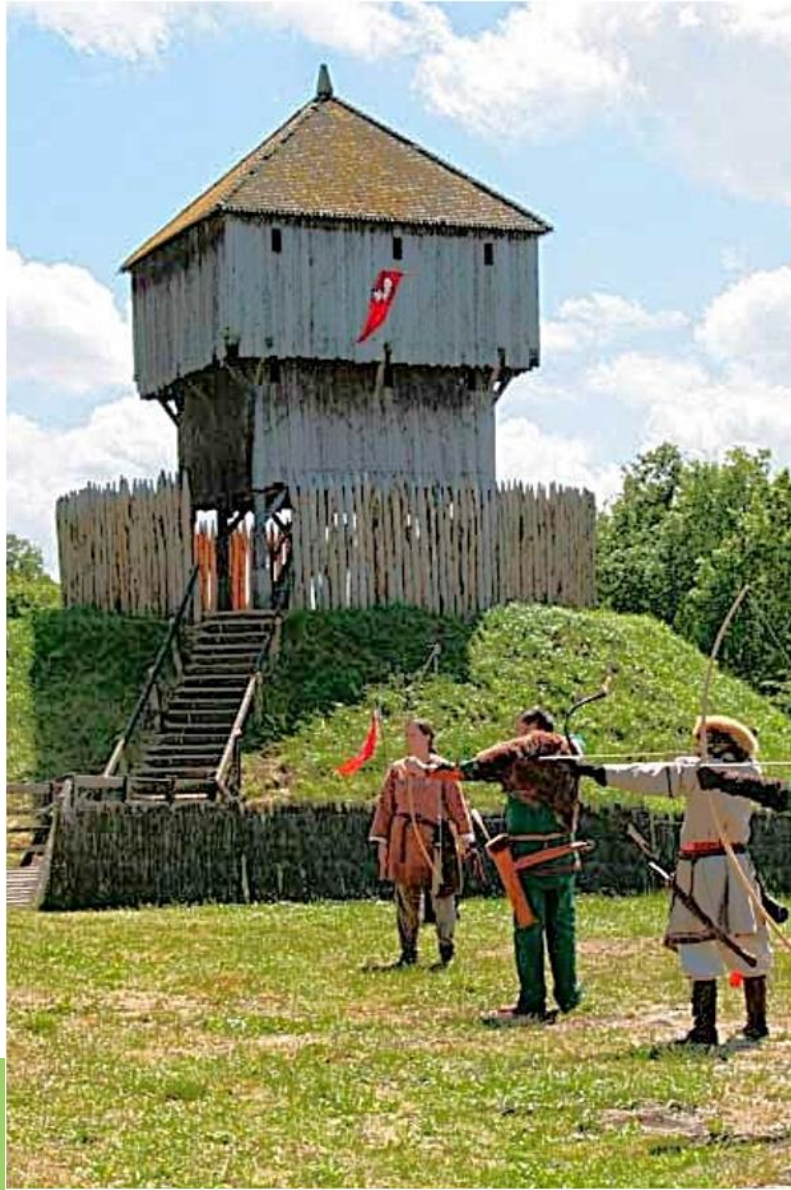
